

Products according directives 2002/95/EG (RoHS) and 2011/65/EU (RoHS2)

The directive 2002/95/EG (RoHS), effective since July 1st 2006, specifies the restriction of various hazardous chemical substances in electronic and electrical equipment.

The new directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS2) is effective since January 1st 2013 and replaced the former directive RoHS. RoHS 2 deals with the same hazardous substances and the same maximum concentration limits.

According to the information from our material suppliers, we can confirm that the chemicals and elements specified below are compliant with the RoHS 2 directive:

- Lead (Pb)	0,1%
- Mercury (Hg)	0,1 %
- Cadmium (Cd)	0,01 %
- Hexavalent chromuim (Cr6+)	0,1%
- Polybrominated biphenyl (PBB)	0,1%
- Polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE)	0,1%

All products meeting the substance restrictions of RoHS1 remain compliant to the substance restrictions of RoHS2. The RoHS-compliance will be reaffirmed on icotek packaging labels.
